## Key Points:

- EU Members: Most Schengen countries are also EU members, but not all EU countries (like Ireland) are in Schengen.
- Non-EU Schengen Members: Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, and Switzerland are part of Schengen but not the EU.
- Newest Additions: Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, and Romania are the newest members, expanding the area significantly.

- **Employment**

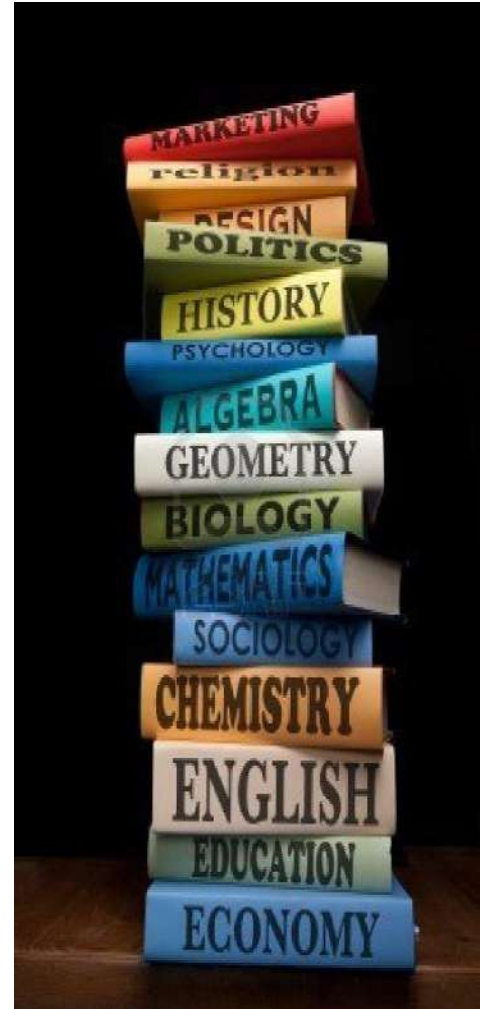
The employment rate for recent graduates in Italy has been improving gradually over recent year

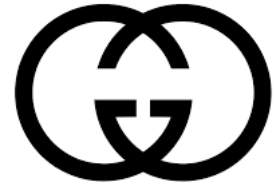

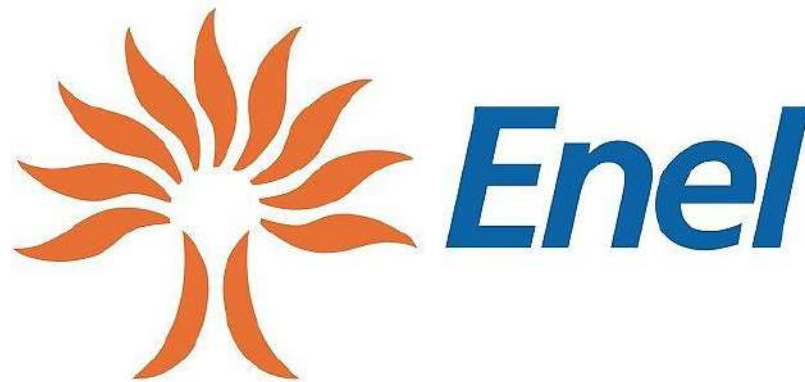

# Entry Requirements

- Medium of Instruction – English.
- IELTS/TOEFL can be waived for application but is required for the visa.
- Student must be fluent in English with good communication skills. Student receives a Telephonic Interview call from school programmer from Italy. The interview is to judge English proficiency of candidate which lasts for 10 to 15 minutes. In addition to this, student is also interviewed by Visa officer during the Visa process.
- Academic percentage – 55% and above

# Application Documents

## Documents required for making an application:

- 10th Marksheet and Certificate.
- 12th Marksheet and Certificate.
- Bachelor's Degree – All individual semester wise /Annual Marksheets.
- Degree Certificate or Provisional Degree Certificate.
- Design Portfolio for Design courses (mandatory).
- Statement of Purpose (SOP)
- Two Letter of Recommendations (LORs) – if any
- Passport Copy – First and Last Page.
- Resume.
- Experience certificate – if any.

# JURISDICTION (to be selected based on current 6 months stay of student)



Applications from residents of New Delhi, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Punjab, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Chandigarh are to be decided by the [Embassy of Italy in New Delhi](#).

Applications from residents of Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Goa, Gujarat, Kerala, Maharashtra, Daman and Diu, Dadra, Nagar Haveli, Lakshadweep are to be decided by the [Consulate of Italy in Mumbai](#).

Applications from residents of Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Puducherry are to be decided by the [Consulate of Italy in Bengaluru](#).

Applications from residents of the States of Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Orissa, Tripura, Sikkim and West Bengal, the Union Territory of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Nepal are to be decided by the [Consulate of Italy in Kolkata](#).

**Ensure there are no discrepancies in the information provided across all the submitted documents. If there is a discrepancy in the applicant's name (or the sponsor's name) between the passport and any of the other documents, a "One and the Same" certificate, duly attested and apostilled, must be submitted.**



# Documents required for Visa



- Complete visa application form.
- Offer letter of the Institution duly signed and stamped by an authorized person of the Institution.
- Work Experience Certificate (if any) duly signed and stamped by an authorized person of the Organization.
- Last Academic Qualification – apostilled and stamped by MEA and HRD/HED. (Attestation by Sub-divisional Magistrate (SDM) is not accepted)
- Declaration of Value – DOV (if required by the university)
- Booked Accommodation– 1 month minimum
- Flight ticket booking – one way
- Travel Medical Insurance of 30,000 Euros coverage of at least for 3 months.
- English language proficiency (mandatory- as per jurisdiction)
- Visa SOP
- Cover Letter
- **VISA FEES – EUR 50( approx.)**



# Documents required for Visa



- **FINANCIALS:**

**Proof of means of support in Italy of not less than Euro 534.41 for each month, or 6.947,33 annually. We recommend to show for UG program 20 lacs INR and for PG program 14 lacs INR**

This availability can be proven through:

1. **According to the Ministry of Education's Rules and Regulations in force, only parents can act as sponsor. No other family member is eligible.**
  - 6 months' original bank statement of applicant/ applicant's parents stamped and signed by the bank authorities
  - Documents proving applicant's/parents' source of income (employment/business activity proof, salary slips, ITR for last 3 years, etc.)
  - Parents' ID proof and original sponsorship letter (affidavit)
2. **Educational loan** (it will be accepted only if deposited and visible on bank statements submitted by the applicant) Else, the relevance shall be evaluated on a case-to-case basis.

# Student Journey



## **12 steps, defining end-to-end journey targeting Regional Scholarship.**

- 1. University Shortlisting and Application**
- 2. Getting confirmation (Offer's TAT= 45-60 days) and accept Offer by paying Matriculation fees.**
- 3. Pre-enrollment at University and getting Pre-enrollment summery (TAT = 2 weeks)**
- 4. Getting all documents Translated and Apostilled (TAT=2 weeks),**
- 5. Declare family income in ISEE Parificato and get certificate (TAT 1 week)**
- 6. Booked Accommodation – 1 month minimum, buy Travel Medical insurance and book flight.**
- 7. Register for Scholarship and submit soft copies of documents.**
- 8. Apply DOV, at VFS (DOV's TAT= 30-35 days)**
- 9. Start VISA application and book slot for interview.**
- 10. Attend the Interview. DOV and VISA can be applied at the same time at VFS.**
- 11. Get VISA (TAT= 30-60 days) and fly to Italy. Get enrolled in the university**
- 12. Submit physical copies of all the documents to scholarship authority and wait for rank release.**
